COMPANION COURSE

The Companion Course, based on the Accelerated Learning Programs (ALP) model, allows students who place at the *introductory level* to take two writing courses at the same time. Advising and permission of the Instructor or CPDS Chair is required. This is a great option for highly motivated students who want to complete their freshmen English requirement on time and save a full semester of coursework. Courses include:

PRPE A108 (3 cr.) Intro to College Writing

Smart Start Program

Students placing at the *developmental level* are encouraged to enroll in the fall Smart Start program which includes 10-week intensive courses with small class sizes and a supportive, cohort model environment to build confidence and strengthen learning skills. This is also a great option for students who work into the early fall season or need a shortened semester schedule.
